TERM DATES

SFU operates on a unique trimester system, comprised of <u>3 equal full-time</u> terms per year. Exchange and study abroad students are welcome in the Fall, Spring or Summer terms (normally for either 1 or 2 terms).

Fall Term

Orientation: Early September Classes: Early September - Early December (13 weeks) Exams: Early December - Mid December (2 weeks)

Summer Term

Orientation: Early May Classes: Early May - Early August (13 weeks) Exams: Early August - Mid August (2 weeks)

APPLYING

Spring Term

Orientation: Early January Classes: Early January - Early April (13 weeks) Exams: Early April - Mid April (2 weeks)
