Incoming Exchange Students Scholarship Guidelines

Revised 21st Sept. 2022 by the Overseas Student Scholarship Review Committee
To take effect following the approval of the International and Exchange Student Committee

1. This scholarship was initiated to encourage students from Tamkang University's (TKU) partner universities to study at TKU, to enhance academic cooperation between TKU and partner universities, and to promote internationalization at TKU.
2. Funding: Each student will receive NT \$10,000 per semester for a maximum duration of one academic year.
3. Quota: The number of scholarships granted may vary according to the university's annual budget.
4. Application eligibility:
 - a. This scholarship is made available to exchange students from partner universities that have academic collaboration agreements with TKU, with the exception of partner universities from Mainland China. To be eligible, undergraduate students must maintain an average academic grade of 65 or above (or GPA 2.5); graduate students must maintain an average academic grade of 75 or above (or GPA 3). Students must also behave well and maintain a clean record of conduct.
 - b. Prospective students may apply for the scholarship while submitting an admissions application. Enrolled students may file an application three weeks before the final examination week of the first semester. The application deadline is one week before the final examination week.
5. Required documents:
 - (1) Application Form
 - (2) Official academic transcript from home institution. (Not required for enrolled students, whose transcripts will be obtained from the Office of Academic Affairs.)
6. Applicants must view participation in "Chat Corner" as a priority in the period in which they are receiving the scholarship.
7. Based on the principle of equal reciprocity, if partner universities grant scholarships to exchange students from TKU, the latter will respond in kind by apportioning an equivalent number of scholarships to exchange students from such universities. The remaining scholarship places will then be open for regular scholarship application.
8. All scholarship applications and their supporting documents will be evaluated by the Overseas Student Scholarship Review Committee.
9. The above regulations take effect from the date of their promulgation, after being approved by the International and Exchange Student Committee. The same applies to any amendments made thereafter.
